Type of Evidence		Sketch & Explain
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Live animal</b></p> <p><i>If you're lucky you might just see an animal instead of only seeing what it leaves behind!</i></p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Tracks</b></p> <p><i>If the ground is soft animals can leave behind footprints. Look in mud, sand, or snow.</i></p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Scat (Poop)</b></p> <p><i>Everybody poops! Animal scat is a great way to figure out which animals live in your area.</i></p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Nest, Burrow, or Lodge</b></p> <p><i>Animals need a place to hide and raise their young. Look in trees, underground, or at the edge of water.</i></p>	
<input type="checkbox"/>	<p><b>Food Scraps</b></p> <p><i>Look around for things that have been chewed on! Twigs, cones, nuts, or even bones.</i></p>
