

TEACHER PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

September 9, 2022 | Edmonton & Calgary

In 2021 & 2022, Inside Education collaborated with the Global, Environmental, and Outdoor Education Council (GEOEC) to produce an education tool kit to support Division 1 teachers in getting their students outside of their traditional classrooms and into nature. The K-3 Explorer Tool Kit was developed with this goal, comprising of a backpack full of activities and a teacher's guide to support learning outcomes using the outdoors as a classroom.

The first round of the tool kits was distributed during a teacher's professional development program hosted in Edmonton and Calgary on September 9, 2022 - during this two-hour, after school PD, the kit contents and activities and contents were showcased to 29 teachers and educators from across the province!
